- All seams are 1/4 inch unless otherwise stated
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- " = inches
- Read all directions before starting.
- · Backing adds 1 inch for Quilting

Fabric Requirements


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS STANDARD MINI LARGE 12"X36" 12"X12" 12"X48" (1) Fat 1/4 yard Fabric A 1/3 yard Quarter (red) (1) Fat 1/4 yard 1/4 yard Fabric B Quarter (blue) Fabric C (1) Fat 1/3 yard 1/2 yard (white) Quarter (1) Fat Binding 1/4 yard 1/4 yard Quarter 13" square 0r Backing 1/2 yard 2/3 yard 13" off the bolt

Piecing Half Square Triangles (HST)

- 1. Take the White and Red 4" squares and place them right sides together.
- 2. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner and stitch 1/4 inch away from the line on both sides.
- 3.cut down the line, separating the 2 HST and press open.
- 4. Trim (square) to 3.5 inches. You should have a total of 4 HST for each block.



Piecing the Outside Triangles

- 1. Use the White 7 inch squares and the Red 3.5 inch squares.
- 2. With right sides together, line up 2 Red squares diagonally across from each other. Shown is figure 1 below.
- 3. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the Red square from the top left to the bottom right and stitch on the line.
- 4. Trim to 1/4 inch seam and press open.
- 5. Then cut the White 7 inch square with now Red tips in half on the diagonal. Shown in Figure 2.
- 6. You should have a total of 4 red tipped triangles for each block.
- 7. Take the Blue 5.25 inch squares and cut them in half diagonally from corner to corner to create 2 triangles. You should have a total of 4 for each block. Shown in Figure 3.








Block Assembly

- 1. Sew the 4 HST together in a pinwheel to create the center of the block. Trim pinwheel (if needed) to 6.5 inches. Shown in Figure 1.
- 2. Sew the blue triangles to the pin wheel. First on the sides, then on the top and bottom. There should be an overlap of the blue triangles for seam allowance. Trim block (if needed) to 9 inches. Shown in Figure 2.
- 3. Sew on the red tipped triangles to complete the block. First on the sides, then on the top and bottom. There should be an overlap of the triangles for seam allowance. Trim block to 12.5 inches. Shown in Figure 3.



Quilt Assembly

Mini: Then quilt and bind as desired. I used 2.5 in strips in my binding.

Standard Size: Sew together your 3 blocks in a row. Shown in Figure 2 below. Then quilt and bind as desired. I used 2.5 in strips in my binding.

Large: Sew together your 4 blocks in a row. Shown in Figure 3 below. Then quilt and bind as desired. I used 2.5 in strips in my binding.







Binding	(1) Fat Quarter	1/4 yard	1/4 yard	
Backing	13" square 0r 13" off the bolt	1/2 yard	2/3 yard	



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
